

# ITINERARY

**Day 1: Sun 2 Mar (Aus-Israel).** Board your Thai Airways flight to Bangkok, then transfer to El Al Airlines for the flight to Tel Aviv.

**Day 2: Mon 3 Mar (the Coastal Plain).** Arrive Tel Aviv early morning and start your tour at Neot Kedumim Biblical Reserve for a “Biblical” breakfast. Head to Nazareth, stopping on the way at Caesarea Maritima, the harbour city built by Herod the Great and Mount Carmel where Elijah took on the false prophets. Get a good night sleep in Nazareth after the long trip!

**Day 3: Tue 4 Mar (Galilee).** Enjoy a spectacular view from the top of Mount Arbel. Hike down the cliffs\* past caves where the Jews held out against the Romans, to the valley floor where Jesus hiked to Galilee. Visit Tabgha and Capernaum, the centre of Jesus’s ministry. Experience a sail on the Sea of Galilee. View the remains of a boat from Jesus’s day. Reflect at the Mount of Beatitudes, where you can relive the Sermon on the Mount. Overnight in a Galilean Kibbutz.

**Day 4: Wed 5 Mar (Golan Heights).** Explore the source of the Jordan and walk through a bush trail to Tel Dan, the capital of the Northern Kingdom and the site of Jeroboam’s rebellion. Continue to Caesarea Phillippi, the ‘gates of hell,’ and Banias Falls. Venture into the ruins of the Nimrod Crusader castle. Ascend the Golan Heights and from Mt. Bental, peer deep into Syria and the ghost town of Kuneitra. Overnight in Galilee.

**Day 5: Thu 6 Mar (Descend to the Dead Sea).** Depart the Sea of Galilee via the fertile Jordan Valley. See the ancient city of Beth Shean, then proceed to the Dead Sea for an afternoon camel ride to your Bedouin hafla (feast) and hear about the local Bedouin lifestyle. Sleep that night in a Bedouin tent.

**Day 6: Fri 7 Mar.**

After breakfast, climb the ancient siege ramp to the mountain fortress of Masada. Take the cable car down the other side, then float in the Dead Sea before continuing to Ein Gedi and a hike to the waterfalls. Walk the ruins of Qumran, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found. Finally, enter Jerusalem and visit the Western Wall in time for the coming of the Sabbath. Overnight inside the Old City walls of Jerusalem!



**Day 7: Sat 8 Mar (Jerusalem).** Start with a spectacular view from the Mt. of Olives, then walk the Palm Sunday road and spend some time of reflection amongst the ancient olive trees. Visit the dungeon at Gallicantu before a service in the Garden Tomb. Overnight in Jerusalem.

**Day 8: Sun 9 Mar (Jerusalem).** Explore the Old City and visit the Pools of Bethesda and the Strouthian Pools. Take a walking tour of the Old City over rooftops and through narrow streets and end at the Southern Wall excavations adjacent to the Temple Mount. Overnight in Jerusalem.

**Day 9: Mon 10 Mar (Jerusalem).** Visit the Temple Mount (subject to security clearance), and the western wall. Take an underground tour of the Western Wall Tunnels. Finish in the City of David exploring Hezekiah’s Tunnel\* by candlelight, knee deep in underground water. Overnight in Yad Hashmona in the Judean hills.

**Day 10: Tue 11 Mar (Jerusalem).** Explore Zedekiah’s cave beneath the Old City of Jerusalem. Then enjoy free time wandering the winding alleyways and market stalls of the Old City above. Overnight in Yad Hasmona.

**Day 11: Wed 12 Mar (Jerusalem).** Visit a model of Jerusalem as it was in Jesus’s day. Experience a moving visit to Yad Vashem Holocaust Memorial. Enjoy a festive farewell dinner. Depart to the airport for your El Al Airlines flight to Bangkok.

**Day 13 (day 12 lost in travel) Fri 14 Mar** Arrive back in Australia with wonderful memories of a fantastic journey!

*\* You may opt out of the hike down Arbel and the walk through Hezekiah’s tunnel and meet the group at the other end if needed. Other walks, such as Masada and hillsides in Jerusalem are necessary, so a degree of fitness is required ☺*
